



The 2026 Colorado Gather is an exclusive women's retreat set on the breathtaking and private 3 Crown Ranch in Meeker, Colorado, bordering the Flat Tops Wilderness Area. This secluded setting offers a rare sense of peace and space while still providing world-class amenities and exceptional horse facilities.

Monday, August 3rd: Arrival day. Check-in between 4 PM and 6 PM, followed by a 7 PM welcome dinner prepared by our wonderful chefs. Throughout the week, they will prepare three meals daily using locally sourced ingredients—bringing years of experience to elevated, ranch-inspired cuisine.

Breakfast is served daily at 8:30 AM. Coffee and tea are available around the clock, and lunch is offered either as a sit-down meal or a picnic, depending on the day's activities. Evenings feature themed dinners—from cozy meals at the Bear Cabin to open-fire cooking and relaxed grilling under the sky.

Tuesday, August 4th: Yoga to start the day, Ranch facilities tour and horse pairings, followed by a light ride. Then, a relaxed group walk, afternoon pickle ball, and scenic exploration of the ranch, ending the evening with stories around the fire.

Wednesday, August 5th: Ease into the morning with intentional, grounding Pilates led by a Polestar-certified comprehensive instructor, followed by a ride to cattle drive. In the afternoon, enjoy fly fishing, and wind down with a lively, laid-back game night.

Thursday, August 6th: Start the day with an energizing Pilates session or pickle ball, followed by a ride out to the spring, a laid-back arts and crafts session, and an evening walk to pick wild mushrooms. Close the day with a relaxed, creative cowboy poetry session.

Friday, August 7th: Yoga in the morning, complimentary portraits with Beau Simmons (beausimmonsphotography.com), another beautiful horseback ride in the mountains, and time to revisit favorite activities or relax before the final night together.

Saturday, August 8th: "High Country Ranch Day" and fundraiser dinner.
